











### **Jakobswegle**

This 2,5 kilometre (1,55 mi) long nature trail is a miniature version of the famous Camino de Santiago/Way of St. James.

The circular trail represents the route from Giengen to Santiago the Compostela on a scale of 1:1000. It is completed by a 1,7 kilometre (1,05 mi) long section that is part of the original Camino de Santiago/Way of St. James (which historically proven leads through Giengen). Along this trail information boards are providing interesting facts about the major European pilgrim route.

With 587 metres (1925 ft.), Charlotte's Cave is one of the longest caves in southern Germany. Fascinating dripstone formations and a state of the art light installation are waiting for you. The service centre will inform you about the origin and discovery of Charlotte's Cave. # **Alte Mühle Burgberg**

This lovingly restored mill dates back to 1344 and draws you into the Middle Ages.

The historical monument has been converted into a place that demonstrates how people lived and worked hundreds of years ago and a museum that displays one of Germany's largest mill wheels.
